All club officials responsible for the Pro-10 Championship, and all Skips

The competition will take place on Saturday 2 and Sunday 3 July 2022. Play on both days starts at 09h00.

Sponsor

- Remember to mention PERSONAL TRUST during your welcome and during all announcements.

Player Movement

- Leads may only approach the head after delivering their bowls.
- Skips may approach the head after delivery of each of their bowls.

Scorecards

- Ensure that the Club name and correct initials and surnames of all the players (including reserves) are recorded on the front of the score cards before play commences.
- Ensure that the surnames of the opposing Skips appear on the reverse of the scorecard above each column of the end-to-end scores.

Conditions of Play

- The format of play in each game will be 2-bowl Pairs.
- Scoring on each end shall be on a 4-3-2-1 basis, with the bowl nearest the jack scoring 4 points, the second closest 3 points, the third closest 2 points and the fourth closest 1 point.
- The team with the bowl closest to the jack shall take the mat on the next end.
- All games shall be played over 10 ends with a 10 minute break between games. A light lunch will be available at the players cost after game 3.

Sectional Play on Saturday

- Teams will be allocated to North and South zones for the first day's play.
- Within their zone, teams will be divided into sections of 6.
- Each team will play a Round Robin against the other teams in their section.
- The team scoring the most points (out of a maximum of 500), in each section will progress to Finals Day.

Finals Day on Sunday

- The six Section winners will play a Round Robin against each other
- The winners will be determined by the teams scoring the most points (out of a maximum of 500).

Determination of Winners

- If teams finish on the same total number of points, the winning team will be determined by playing a single end.

Scores

- After each match ensure that the scorecard has been signed by both skips and the umpire.
- Results must be submitted to competitions@wpbowls.co.za and admin@wpbowls.co.za, or by WhatsApp to 079 876 6485.
- Retain the completed score sheets and scorecards at the Club
